Tinana State School will receive

\$224,347*

This funding will be used to

- Develop consistent, high yield systems and approaches that ensure every student is achieving 12 months growth for 12 months of teaching
- Ensure all students in year 3 and 5 achieve the National Minimum Standard for Writing, Reading and Numeracy on the National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) or, are on an individual learning program.
- Ensure all students achieve either an A, B or C on the Australian Curriculum English, Mathematics and Science.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A or B on Australian Curriculum Mathematics, English and Science from semester 1, 2019 to semester 1, 2020.

Our initiatives include

- Ensure consistently inclusive practice in every classroom to support students with additional needs to achieve with and on the same basis as their age appropriate peers
- Embed a Gradual Release Model of Instruction within every classroom across the school to ensure differentiated teaching occurs in areas of Reading, Writing and Numeracy
- Provision of a Literacy and Numeracy Coach to enhance teacher pedagogical capability through a Growth Coaching model inclusive of observation and feedback
- Provision of additional scheduled classroom teacher aides in every classroom to support differentiated teaching and learning
- Provide teacher release time to deepen teacher knowledge of the curriculum through facilitated Pre and Post Moderation Planning inclusive of individualised planning to modify the curriculum for identified students
- Engage in both in-school and across school moderation opportunities to ensure consistency of judgment within and across local schools in English and Mathematics

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Funding Pedagogy Coaches to support enhanced teacher practice in high yield English and Mathematics pedagogies - \$140,000
- Funding additional teacher aide support – \$80,000
- Funding provision of additional resources – levelled reading books, common teaching visuals, online resources eg Reading Eggs \$5,000
